FELLOW PROGRAM IN MANAGEMENT (FPM)

Fellow Program in Management(FPM) is an AICTE approved doctoral level program at Jaipuria Institute of Management Jaipur which is focused to develop the research scholars in the field of academia and research through rigorous course work, quality research work (as prescribed by the AICTE) and continuous mentoring process. The FPM, being a doctoral level program, requires commitment and intellectual contribution of participants and the institute.

With the introduction of FPM, Jaipuria Institute of Management, Jaipur aims at strengthening the research culture, improve the quality and quantity of publication output, improve the research skills of faculty members, and groom young scholars in the field of management who eventually can enter into the field of academic and take up faculty position.

Successful completion of the program is dependent on two requirements –one, participant must pass all the courses prescribed in the course curriculum, and two, submission and successfully defending the thesis

within the rules and regulations of the program. The functioning of the program will be administered by the Program Director (FPM) and guided by the FPM Committee.

AREA OF RESEARCH

Scholars are required to complete their thesis in any one of the areas of specialization;

- Finance
- Marketing Management
- Human Resource Management
- Economics & Public Policy
- Information Technology
- Operations Management
- Business Analytics
- Interdisciplinary and Cross-functional Areas of Management
- Any other area with due approval of FPM Committee

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Duration of program is as follows:

- Mandatory Course Work: 1 Year (Maximum within 2 years for those who will not be able to complete the course work in 1 year)
- Registration of Topic: After completion of course work
- Submission of Thesis: Minimum of 2 years of research work after registration
- Maximum Duration: 5 years from the date of admission
- Additional period of two years may be granted with the approval of FPM Committee under extraordinary conditions (by using the re-registration clause prescribed by AICTE and payment of fee)

COURSE WORK

As prescribed by AICTE, the FPM participant has to earn 30 credits from following 10 courses:

The participant can earn 12 credits (from 4 courses of 3 credit each in module 1), 12 credits (from 4 courses of 3 credit each in module 2) and 6 credits (from 2 courses of 3 credit each in module 3). The participant has to secure minimum 60% marks to qualify these courses. The candidate must complete the courses work (with passing grade in all course) within maximum of 2 years from the commencement of the program.

AREA OF RESEARCH

FPM thesis can be done in following areas of specialization:

- Finance • Marketing Management • Human Resource Management • Economics & Public Policy
- Information Technology • Operations Management • Business Analytics
- Interdisciplinary and Cross-functional Areas of Management • Any other area with due approval of FPM Committee

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

The participant will earn the doctoral level degree as “Fellow in Management” after successful completion of the following:

- Qualifying all the courses prescribed in the course work with minimum 60% marks in each course.
- Publishing two research papers (at least one in Scopus indexed journals).

- On receipt of two positive reports from thesis evaluators appreciating the quality of research work and recommending for award of the degree to the participant.

CONDUCT, DISCIPLINE AND ACADEMIC HONESTY

The participants enrolled in the FPM are expected to maintain the highest standards of conduct, discipline and academic honesty. Academic dishonesty includes, but limited to, the following:

- **Compliance to plagiarism policy:** The thesis, all project reports and course-related assignments, etc. need to be submitted through dashboard interface within the prescribed time limits. All submissions will be screened for plagiarism check and will call for resubmission/ rejection (within the extended time frame as will be notified) in case of submission found plagiarized for more than 20 percent.
- **Cheating:** Giving or receiving unauthorized assistance in any academic exercise of examination

which includes using or attempting to use any unauthorized materials, information or study aids in an examination or academic exercise.

- **Falsification:** Falsifying or inventing any information, data or citation in an academic exercise.
- **Multiple Submissions:** Submitting substantial portions of any academic exercise more than once for credit without the prior authorization and approval of the current instructor.
- **Conduct and Discipline:** The institute’s rules and regulations related to conduct and discipline as enshrined in handbook/ service book or otherwise will be applicable to FPM candidates as well.

SELECTION OF THESIS SUPERVISOR

After completion of the coursework, the participants will submit their preference (minimum 3 names) for appointment of the thesis supervisor. For a participant, there will be two thesis supervisors (either both from the institute or one from institute and one from outside).

The FPM Committee will decide upon the appointment of thesis supervisor for the participant. The FPM Committee will reserve the right to select supervisor outside the list of preference submitted by the candidate.

THESIS SUBMISSION AND EVALUATION

After the successful completion of the coursework, the participants will present the synopsis (pre-registration proposal) to the panel as designated by the FPM Committee for registration of their topic. Once the topic is approved and registered, the participants will conduct research work on the topic and develop the thesis. Thesis must be the presentation of original idea and carry significant contribution in the existing body of knowledge. The participants can submit the thesis any time after the completion of 3 years in the program (from date of admissions). There will be Pre-synopsis

Seminar before submission of final thesis. A total of 6 copies of the final thesis needs to be submitted for examination (3 for external examiners, 1 for institute record, 1 for supervisor and 1 for the candidate).

For evaluation of thesis, after consultation with respective supervisors, the Program Director (FPM) will propose a list of 8 experts (5 from India and 3 from abroad) from the subject area to the FPM Committee. The FPM Committee will select three experts from the list (two from India and one from abroad) and thesis will be sent for evaluation to the selected experts.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (JAIPURIA RESEARCH FELLOW)

The financial assistance is available in the form of Jaipuria Research Fellow (JRF) for a maximum of two FPM candidates each year. The JRF will be available for a maximum of three years, subject to fulfillment of attendance norms, progress report and other criteria as prescribed by FPM Committee. The benefits attached to JRF is as follows:

- The academic fee will be waived off.
- Fellowship of Rs. 20000/- per month will be awarded.
- The contingency grant of Rs. 20000/- per year will be granted for participation in conferences, FDP, workshops, purchase of stationary and books etc.

ADMISSION CRITERIA (ELIGIBILITY)

The participants with master degree or equivalent in Management, Engineering and Technology, Social Science, Commerce, Humanities with first class are eligible for admission in the program

ADMISSION PROCESS (HOW TO APPLY)

After the admission notification published in local newspaper and also published on institute's website (https://www.jaipuria.ac.in/campuses/jaipuria-jaipur/fellow_program) during the month of May-June 2019, candidates have to fill-in the prescribed application and provide self-attested copies of all the credentials as required in the form. After receiving the forms, the same will be shortlisted by the FPM committee

and the admit cards for written exam will be sent to candidates (The candidates with valid CAT/GMAT/NET-JRF score may be exempted from written test, subject to the decision by the FPM Committee on the exemption cut-off percentile). After written test, the shortlisted candidates will be called for personal interview and research proposal presentation. The dates for admission process are as follows;
